Request for Information – ATISN reference 10045

Thank you for your request which was received by the Welsh Government on 15 December 2015. You asked for the following information:

Please outline how much the Welsh Government has spent on potted plants and other decorative fauna in 2013/14, 2014/15 and to date during 2015/16.

You confirmed you were seeking information on decorative flora as opposed to fauna.

Potted plants and other decorative flora are provided on Welsh Government's administrative estate as part of its facilities management service contract arrangements. However, as these contracts deliver a wide range of services, with payments made on an aggregated basis, information is not held on the specific costs of delivering these particular elements.

In addition, expenditure, which is separately identifiable, has been incurred on potted plants and Christmas flora (Christmas trees) at various Cadw historic sites as follows:
