ATISN 10057 – LAN Information

Thank you for your request which was received by the Welsh Government on the 18th December 2015.

You asked for information regarding the Local Area Network (LAN) contract within Welsh Government. Welsh Government does not hold a LAN contract, although network management is provided as a service in our larger ICT Services contract with Atos. This contract commenced on the 1st May 2004 and is due to expire on the 11th January 2019. This is not a discrete element of the contract.

With respect to our LAN contract, you asked for:

1. Existing Supplier: Who is the current supplier for each contract?

Atos provide the ICT Services contract of which LAN services are a part.

2. Annual Average Spend for Supplier: What is the annual average spending on the supplier above? If there is more than one supplier please split the annual averages spend for each supplier.

We are unable to disaggregate the LAN spend from the larger ICT contract, so we do not hold the requested information.

3. Number of Users: Please can you provide me with the number of users each contract covers. Approximate number of users will also be acceptable.

4. Number of Sites: The number of sites where equipment is supported by these contract.

5. Contract Type: For each contract is the contract Managed, Maintenance, Installation, Software

There is no specific LAN contract, it is part of the wider ICT Services contract.

6. Hardware Brand: What is the hardware brand of the LAN equipment?

The LAN switches are supplied by Cisco, these are being replaced by Juniper switches in the coming year.

7. Contract Description: Please provide me with a brief description of the overall contract.

We do not hold the requested information as there is no LAN contract. LAN services are packaged into our overall Atos ICT Services contract.

8. Contract Duration: What is the duration of the contract is and can you please also include any extensions this may include for each contract.

The Atos ICT Services contract is due to expire on the 11th January 2019 and cannot be extended.

9. Contract Expiry Date: When does the contract expire for each contract?

The Atos ICT Services contract is due to expire on the 11th January 2019.

10. Contract Review Date: When will the organisation is planning to review the contract?

Currently there is no Contract Review Date as there are no plans to renew the contract.

11. Responsible Officer: Who within the organisation is responsible for each of these contract(s) please provide me with contact details including name, job title, contact number and email address?
