Request for Information - ATISN 10101

We wrote to you on 20 January regarding your request for information concerning the scheduled monument known as Offa's Dyke – Section N and S of Plas-Offa (DE138).

You asked for the following information in connection with damage to the monument that occurred in 2013;

- The conclusion reached by Cadw as to whether the existence of the Scheduled Monument was properly shown on the 2010 Land Charge Register.
- The date of most recent previous inspection of the monument by the Field Monument Warden and the report on the visit
- 3 The date on which the site was scheduled.

I will respond to your request for information in the order as set out above.

- Cadw did not reach any conclusion about whether the Scheduled Monument was properly shown on the 2010 Land Charge Register. This was a matter for the police.
- 2. The section of the monument which was damaged in 2013 (DE138 B) was last formally inspected by our Field Monument Warden in December 2013, and the site visit report is enclosed. I should explain that the report's reference to photographs is an administrative error. I can confirm that no photographs were taken during the site visit.

Names have been redacted under Section 40(2), (third party personal data) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The reason for applying this exemption is set out at Annex 1 of this document.

3. The monument was scheduled on 23 July 1930.
