Request for Information – ATISN reference 10046

Thank you for your request which was received by the Welsh Government on 17 January 2016. You asked for the following information:

- Will you state which confidential Welsh Government papers and documents are supplied to The UK Government; and
- Will you state if confidential Welsh Government Cabinet papers and minutes are supplied to The UK Government.

On 1st February, I wrote to you with a request for clarification on the exact information you were seeking i.e. are you seeking the 'class' or 'type' of document that is currently routinely supplied either through business/MoU or a legal obligation as opposed to an actual list of documents. As I did not receive clarification, I am unable to progress this part of your request. Should you wish to resubmit a reformulated request, please could you be as specific as possible on the information sought.

With regard to Cabinet Papers and minutes, these are not supplied to the UK Government. However, Cabinet papers and the minutes of the meetings to which they relate are routinely published.

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response. Requests for an internal review should be addressed to the Welsh Government's Freedom of Information Officer at:
