Request for Information – ATISN 10160

I wrote to you on 8 February regarding your request for information. You asked for details relating to the purchase of land at Ty Du, Nelson, in particular, the dates and parcels of land being considered for development.

I can confirm that we hold information relating to your request. The land was purchased by the Welsh Development Agency on 10 November, 1997. I have concluded that the details for land being considered for development are exempt from disclosure under Section 21 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, information otherwise available. The following link provides information for the Local Development Plan for Caerphilly CBC. Under the heading 'Replacement Local Development Plan up to 2031' the third link 'Proposals Map (PDF)' identifies the larger site of which Welsh Government forms a part on pages 18 and 24.
