Request for Information – ATISN 10246

Thank you for your request for information which I received on 1 March. You have asked for information relating to the Cardiff Airport Express (T9) bus service.

You have asked for information on the number of passengers who used the service, a breakdown of the number of passengers per month showing the numbers moving in each direction, and the total subsidy for the period 1 August 2015 to 29 February 2016. You also asked for the monthly running cost and information regarding any review process that exists regarding the T9 service.

I can confirm that we hold some information relating to your request.

During the time period specified, 93,279 passengers used the service and it received a subsidy of £290,607. In August 2015, there were 10,012 passengers, in September 11,879, in October 22,258, in November 13,090, in December 11,740, in January 2016 11,359 and in February 13,041. We do not hold information relating to the numbers of passengers travelling in each direction.
