Thanks for your email and involving us in potential changes that compliment our shared planning reform agenda.

The legacy terminology from Table 1 does provide clarity and I believe has served its purpose adequately. As we move forward with the reform agenda emanating from the Planning (Wales) Act it does make sense to review its purpose. With this in mind

the 'Object – Recommend refusal unless/until' category could be updated to reflect positive planning terminology.

In transferring the purpose of this category to your Table 2 it may be beneficial to move away from the term 'object' which would be reserved solely for the final category where there would be an objection in principal. Perhaps terminology could reflect NRW 'concerns' unless such matters are addressed in the form of such and such.

To quote the DMPWO:

15A.-3(c) advises the consultor of any concerns identified in relation to the proposed development and how those concerns can be addressed by the applicant

I have attached a copy of Article 7of the Town and Country Planning (Development Management Procedure) (Wales) (Amendment) Order 2015. This identifies the 4 levels of substantive response Ministers would expect from NRW. Due to the annual reporting requirement (15B) I would recommend NRW arrange their substantive responses based on the 4 levels mentioned. In theory this should make annual reporting an easier proposition for NRW. This approach can also apply to DNS.

I am on leave from this Friday until 29 September. I would be happy to meet in October to discuss the terminology further which would also give you time to collect comments from POSW. In the meantime my colleague James Hooker (copied in) will be available in my absence for urgent matters.

We have talked previously about the response categories that are being used by Natural Resources Wales in providing our advice to planning applications, definitions of substantive response and reporting that will be required against these categories as we move forward.

We are looking again at the wording we use and wondered if you, or others, would be able to have a look at this for us and perhaps have a discussion with us on this basis?

The current response categories are based on terminology which our legacy bodies developed with Local Planning Authorities to ensure that we communicated our advice to them in a way which was both clear and which set out our advice on what should happen as a result of our advice. We are currently seeking views from LPAs via POSW particularly around the terminology and how helpful/clear it is and what would provide the clearest advice on our position for them in going forward.

As we finalise our thinking we wanted to road test this with you, especially around -

- Terminology used now in our response categories and how helpful/clear it is (see table 1)
- What terminology would provide the clearest advice on our position in going forward, especially in the context of advice we would provide in responding to consultations involving Developments of National Significance (see table 2).
- Are there are alternatives to what we propose? For example the extent to
 which we could adapt the language to be more closely aligned with the
 positive planning agenda whilst at the same time making sure our advice is
 clear and the intention well understood. (see table 2)
- And finally do our categories 'map across' to the definitions of substantive response to enable us report clearly on our performance (see table 2)

Current NRW Response Category	When used
