Complaint in respect of Request for Information – reference ATISN 10403

I wrote to you on 27 May regarding your request for an internal review. I have conducted an internal review in accordance with the procedure outlined in the <u>Welsh Government's Practical Guide for Making Requests for Information</u> which is available by post on request, or via the internet.

I note in your original request you asked for information relating to Superfast Broadband in Wales. In our response dated 25 May, the information you requested (where held by Welsh Government) was provided and some was exempt under section 21 (information accessible by other means) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. In your email complaint of 25 May you have asked us to provide the missing data in relation to question 8 of your original request.

You asked - 8. And what is the WG projected final Budget for Wales' Superfast broadband

We replied - The projected final budget for the Superfast Cymru intervention is £224 million, which includes contributions from the UK Government and the EU.

I have reviewed your request and have concluded that the response provided was indeed correct. You asked for the projected final budget and we provided this figure. There is no missing data and the complaint is therefore not upheld.
