Request for Information - reference ATI 10574

I write in response to your request which I received on 15 July and further to my acknowledgement letter of 21 July.

I am now enclosing some of the information you requested. A full list of the information caught by the request is enclosed at Annex 1.

I have decided that some of the information is exempt from disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 - section 35(a) - relating to the formulation or development of government policy.

Many of the exchanges relate to the ongoing policy development of the then Environment (Wales) Bill that at the time was going through National Assembly for Wales scrutiny and therefore subject to policy change.

Also, whilst policy has informed the Act itself, which is now in place following Royal Assent earlier this year, it is not the end of the process. It is ongoing in terms of implementation, for example, a significant part of the material being withheld relates to an exchange which is the iteration of the policy around Area Statements and ensuring that this is consistent with the Act.

Regarding Natural Resources Wales' (NRW) purpose itself, again the Act provides NRW with its new purpose but the detailed policy will be set out in guidance. Therefore, the policy for this is not yet complete as we have not issued the guidance to NRW.

It is also considered that public interest in disclosing the withheld information is not greater than withholding it. NRW is one of the Welsh Government's key delivery bodies and we would not want to constrain our relationship with it. It is important that the Welsh Government works jointly with NRW in order to share early drafts and co-produce documents prior to publication.
