Request for Information – ATISN 10598

I wrote to you on 27 July regarding your request for information. You asked for information relating to the amount of public money that has been spent by the Welsh Government and its predecessors on the development and promotion of the M4 Corridor around Newport project since the establishment of the National Assembly for Wales.

I can confirm that we hold information relating to your request. The current total expenditure on the development of a solution to the problems on the M4 around Newport is £57.6 million. This expenditure has covered historical investigation of the problems and consideration of a long list of options to solve those problems at a strategic level including strategic environmental assessment, health impact assessment and equality impact assessment, with associated stakeholder consultation. Expenditure has then covered development of a preferred solution with the associated environmental surveys, assessment and mitigation development. Most recently expenditure has covered production of draft Statutory Orders, an Environmental Statement and associated reporting covering matters including economic assessment and traffic modelling work, and the associated stakeholder liaison work.
