Thank you for your request which I received on the 27 July 2016. You asked:

"I would be grateful if you advise as to the cost to the Welsh Government of responding to Freedom of Information Act requests sent by Plaid Cymru, the Liberal Democrats, and the Conservative parties during each year of the last Assembly term and continuing to the date of this request".

The Welsh Government does not quantify or record the costs involved in responding to freedom of information requests, either individually or in aggregate. Therefore I can confirm that we do not hold the information you have requested.

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response. Requests for an internal review should be addressed to the Welsh Government's Freedom of Information Officer at:
