## Request for Information – ATISN 10629

We wrote to you on 8 August regarding your request for information. You asked what is the additional cost of producing bilingual road signs in Wales, rather than just in English?

I can confirm that we do not hold information relating to your request. It is a requirement that all road signs in Wales are produced bilingually. We do not have any comparison costs for producing signs in English only. However I can confirm that in general that bilingual signs will be more expensive as they are usually larger than their monolingual equivalent.
