Request for Information – ATISN reference 10641

Under your request for information (our reference) ATISN 10465, you sought the following information:

- Supply a copy of the lease agreement between Welsh Government and Mitel Networks for a 'Specialist Facility, Caldicot' (commencing on 16th Feb 2010 I believe). If there are parts of the document you cannot release, please redact them, giving reasons for each redaction.
- Confirm what this facility is what is it used for (the Welsh Government estate report just describes it as a Specialist Facility, with no floor-area - what does this mean?)

Following our disclosure under ATISN 10465, you requested an internal review into our decision to withhold information. Following the completion of our internal review and the subsequent release of information, on 3rd August you submitted a new request seeking the following:

 broken down by facility where they are located, how many servers does the Welsh Government operate? If historic data for the last 5 years is available, please supply that.

Annex 1

The Welsh Government operates an ICT environment that requires the deployment of distributed servers supporting local provision of services at its offices such as printing and device management. In responding to the request to provide a breakdown and location of servers I have not included servers that act as distributed network support devices as described above. Most Welsh Government offices will have one or two servers providing localised ICT network distribution and management services.

The breakdown of servers across datacentres operated by Welsh Government as at 31st July 2016 is as follows:
