Thank you for your email which was received on 24th August. In your email, you made the following request for recorded information:

- How much funding does the National Lottery provide to improve the fitness of seniors over 65 living in Wales

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you require is not held by the Welsh Government.

National Lottery money is given out by 12 independent organisations, each with specialist knowledge of their sectors. Each is independent of Government and follows strict guidelines when deciding which applications for National Lottery funding will be successful.
