The information you requested is enclosed at **Doc 1**. The **Doc 1** information includes details of the initial key targets outlined in the business plan at the beginning of the project, confirmed key targets agreed as part of the final grant offer and the actual key targets achieved at the end of the project (based on final payment claims authorised by WEFO).

All EU funded projects from the 2007-2013 European Structural Funds programmes were required to set output targets as part of their grant award conditions. These output targets contribute to the Operational Programme targets agreed with the European Commission at the outset of the seven-year programme period. WEFO is on track to exceed its agreed key targets for the 2007-2013 programmes and in many cases the agreed targets have already been surpassed by considerable margins.

Throughout the lifespan of a project, targets and indictors may be revised to reflect changes in and the experiences of project delivery, such as those relating to a range of external and internal factors including economic and labour market conditions, findings of independent project evaluations and programme evaluations, tendering and delivery arrangements, infrastructure developments and compliance issues. This usually leads to changes in financial costs (including the amount of EU funds invested), with funds reallocated to other projects as necessary so that we maximise the available funding and achieve overall programme performance targets agreed with the European Commission.

Output target data provided by projects also complements other monitoring and evaluation measures, including mid-year and final evaluations of projects, which are regularly published on the EU funding pages section of the Welsh Government website, which can be accessed via the following web link: http://gov.wales/funding/eu-funds/previous/project-evaluations/?lang=en.
