Request for Information – ATISN reference 10761- internal review

On 16 August, you submitted a request in which you sought the following information:

- 1. How many Microsoft Project 2010 / 2013 courses for Civil Servants working for Welsh Assembly Govt. purchased during this financial year (2016 /2017) and last financial year (2015/2016)?
- 2. Which departments purchased these courses and what was the designation of the officer who approved these purchases?
- 3. Do you have a procurement contract in place with the supplier to deliver these courses?
- 4. How many Microsoft Excel 2010 / 2013 courses for Civil Servants working for Welsh Assembly Govt. purchased during this financial year (2016 /2017) and last financial year (2015/2016)?
- 5. Which departments purchased these courses and what was the designation of the officer who approved these purchase?
- 6. Do you have a procurement contract in place with the supplier to deliver these courses?

In our disclosure response it was confirmed that with regard to questions 1,2, 4 & 5, the Welsh Government does not hold the information requested. In respect of questions 3 & 6, it was also confirmed there is no specific supplier contract in place to provide the courses identified.

On 16 September you requested an internal review into our disclosure stating you were dissatisfied with the response you had received.

As part of my internal review and following discussions with the Deputy Director of HR Expert Services and Deputy Director of ICT Division, they confirmed the position as set out within the original disclosure letter is correct. I can therefore confirm there is no information that can be provided in respect of your request and as such, your complaint is not upheld.
