Request for Information – ATISN 10744

I wrote to you on 20 September regarding your request for information. In your request you asked for:

- All correspondence between the Welsh Government and Cardiff County Council relating to the upgrade of School Lane, Gwaelod y Garth, from 2015-2016.

It has now come to light that the information captured by the request is held by the Planning Directorate. I am therefore providing you with the following response.

I confirm that we hold some information relating to your request. I can advise that the City of Cardiff Council submitted an application to the Aggregate Levy Fund for Wales, which is administered by the Welsh Government, on 2 October 2015. The City of Cardiff Council withdrew this application on 16 November 2015. The application did not reach the stage of being considered by the Welsh Ministers.

The information we hold in relation to your request will follow hard copy in the post. Please provide me with the postal address you would like this information to be sent to. Please note that any personal information contained within these documents has been redacted as this is not relevant to the request.

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response. Requests for an internal review should be addressed to the Welsh Government's Freedom of Information Officer at:
