ATISN 10817: The Inspectors Report into the Vale of Glamorgan Local Development Plan (LDP) Examination

Thank you for your request which I received on 4 October. You asked for:

- A copy of the Inspectors report into the Vale of Glamorgan Local Development Plan (LDP) examination.

The examination process into the LDP is ongoing and will conclude on receipt of the Inspectors report, anticipated in spring 2017. As such, the information you require is not held by Welsh Government. The conclusions reached by the Inspector are binding on the Authority and will not be subject to any comment or amendment by the Welsh Government. It is a statutory requirement for the Authority to publicise and make available the Inspectors report on the Authorities website and at locations where the plan was deposited.

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response.
