Request for Information - ATISN 10925 - Ystalyfera Iron and Tinplate Works

Thank you for your request for information regarding Ystalyfera Iron and Tinplate Works, which we received on 17 November 2016.

You have asked whether we have had any involvement with the Ystalyfera Iron and Tinplate Works site at any time and for copies of any reports which were produced.

The Welsh Government's historic environment service (Cadw) grant-aided a six year project for the Glamorgan-Gwent Archaeological Trust to undertake research into the ironworking landscapes of SE Wales. Year one of the project, completed in 2005, looked at the core ironwork areas and this included the ironworks at Ystalyfera. An extract of the report relating to the Ystalyfera Ironworks is attached. Cadw has not undertaken any subsequent archaeological surveys of the site.

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response.
