ATISN 10951 – Freedom of information request – Wales Compulsory Purchase Orders

Thank you for your request which was received here on 29 November. You asked:

Could you please provide details (address/locations) of any proposed Compulsory Purchase Orders that you are aware of within Wales since 27/09/2016?. When I refer to ‘proposed’ Orders, I am referring to when confirmation by a Government Minister is being sought by a Local Authority.

I wrote to you on the 27 September 2016, and explained that we had identified four Compulsory Purchase Orders which met the criteria set out in your request. There has been no further proposed Compulsory Purchase Orders that meet your criteria since that date.

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government’s handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response. Requests for an internal review should be addressed to the Welsh Government’s Freedom of Information Officer at:
