## Complaint in respect of ATISN 10802 - Freedom of Information request regarding psychiatric patient Paul Khan

In your email of 28 September, you requested the following:

Information about the case of psychiatric patient Paul Khan who was convicted
of the killing of Mr Brian Dodd, to include any documents between the then
NHS Chief Executive Ann Lloyd and her advisers (as clarified) from the period
of the incident on 25 March 2003, to 14 October 2005, the date of the
publication of Healthcare Inspectorate Wales and Health Commission Wales'
joint review. You also requested any subsequent responses from the then
Chief Executive of NHS Wales.

On 22 November, we wrote to you confirming that the Welsh Government holds information that falls within the scope of your request this would be exempt under sections 38 (1)a – health and safety and section 40 (2) – personal data.

You subsequently requested an internal review.

As per my letter of 6th January, I have conducted a review of your case and this letter sets out my conclusion. I am satisfied that the exemption 38 (1)a has been applied correctly in this case, due to the likely impact that the release would have on the mental health of the two living individuals directly involved. With regard to section 40 (2), it is my conclusion that this exemption has also been correctly applied, as release of this information would be unfair and so breach the first data protection principle.
