ATISN 11063 – CCTV / ANPR Cameras

Thank you for your request which I received on 20 January via the North & Mid Wales Trunk Road Agent. You asked for:

1. The number of cameras (CCTV/ANPR) used to enforce moving traffic offences on roads for which you are the responsible highway authority
2. The total length of coverage from all your cameras (CCTV/ANPR) used to enforce moving traffic offences on roads for which you are the responsible highway authority

To confirm that the Welsh Government do not use any CCTV or ANPR for moving traffic offences, this would be a matter for the Police.

However, the Welsh Government do own speed camera equipment at the following locations;

1. M4 J24 to J28 Variable Speed Limit
2. M4 J38 to J42 Average Speed Limit
3. A465 Average Speed Limit between Dowlais Top and Hirwaun.
4. A55 Tunnels Average Speed Limit (used during works only).

This equipment is not managed by the Welsh Government. Furthermore, we possess a number of ANPR cameras situated at strategic points throughout the Motorway and Trunk road network. We use these to calculate journey times based on anonymised data therefore not retaining any meaningful data.

I would suggest Go Safe could help further with this freedom of information request. Go Safe are responsible for red light and speed camera enforcement and can be contacted at:
