Request for Information – ATISN reference 11072

Thank you for your request which was received by the Welsh Government on 26 January 2017. I have provided a response to each of the questions you submitted, as follows.

1. How many meetings has Carwyn Jones had with businesses incorporated in Wales to discuss the impact of Brexit?

This information is not held as the Welsh Government does not hold information on where individual businesses are incorporated.

2. How much has the Welsh Government spent on complying with EU regulations/ directives/ decisions in the last 5 years?

This information is not held. Work related to EU regulations/directives/decisions is often integral to broader policy and delivery work and therefore not separately identifiable within expenditure lines (staff costs or otherwise).

3. If FOI requests of a similar nature have been asked already, please include your responses to those requests.

I can also confirm that following searches using key words including 'Brexit', 'EU since', 'meetings since', no other requests of a similar nature have been received.
