## Doc 1: Schedule of total Welsh Government expenditure to AECOM

- This includes a column of figures for total Welsh Government payments and a seprate column of figures for payments under the heading of sustainable development to AECOM and its predessors companies from 2002-03 to and including 2016-17, to date. The companies identified are :Davis langdon & Everest; Fabermaunsell Ltd; Davislangdon; URS Corporation Ltd; AECOM Ltd; AECOMInas and ENV UK Ltd and AECOM Professional Sevices LLP.
- The heading of Sustainable Development is assumed to include payments from the environment, climate change, decarbonisation and energy, flood and planning divisions of the Environment and Rural Affairs portfolio.
- All figures are provided in financial years.

## Doc 2: Expenditure to AECOM for the Renewable Energy Assessment Toolkit.

- A Toolkit for Local Planning Authorities on Renewable Energy Assessments was commissioned from Aecom, which was updated in 2014.
- Welsh Government expenditure under the "Renewable Energy Assessments" umbrella has been interpreted as individual project related assessment expenditure, which is not itemised within the Welsh Government finance and accounting systems and therefore is not readily available on those systems such that it could be provided within the cost thresholds under Freedom of Information legislation.

In 2008 the Planning Directorate commissioned Aecom (then Faber Maunsell) to prepare a Toolkit for Local Planning Authorities on Renewable Energy Assessments. Based on the information available, this project cost £59,748+ VAT, including associated dissemination. In 2014 we commissioned AECOM to review and update the Toolkit. This project cost £19,922 + VAT.
