Thank you for your request to the Welsh Government for information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000), received on 3 February. You asked for the following information:

- A copy of the Cancer Delivery Plan for Wales
- Details of members of the Cancer Implementation Group
- Further and better particulars about the Velindre Cancer Centre and the Wales Cancer Research Centre

The Welsh Government holds some of the information you requested. The Cancer Delivery Plan for Wales is a published document which is available on the Welsh Government website. It can be accessed via the attached link:

As I am unsure if you have access to the internet, I have enclosed a hard copy of the Plan for you.

The details of the members of the Cancer Implementation Group are also enclosed in hard copy. The list provided is correct as at the 1st July 2016. This is the latest version of the membership of the Group that we have on record. Please note the Welsh Government is not responsible for maintaining this list.

We did not receive any clarification from you regarding the information you are seeking about 'further and better particulars' in relation to the Velindre Cancer Centre and Wales Cancer Research Centre. Without knowing the specific information you are seeking we are unable to provide any information in this respect.

However, in order to be helpful I have enclosed a copy of the Wales Cancer Research Centre's recent annual report. The Centre is led from Cardiff University, but partners include NHS Wales, universities across Wales, cancer charities and the pharmaceutical industry.

The Wales Cancer Research Centre has a strong focus on involving members of the public in research projects, encouraging the public to participate in research studies and engaging the public with information and knowledge about research.
