ATISN 11280 Use of intelligence from ET1 claim forms forwarded by the Employment Tribunal

Thank you for your request which I received on 30th April 2017. You asked;

- 1) How many ET1 claim forms (or excerpts and information related to the claims) for whistleblowing detriment under the Public Interest Disclosure Act has the Housing Regulation Team received from the Employment Tribunal?
- 2) Please advise if the Housing Regulation Team holds data on the action that he or the organisation took in response to these notifications by the Employment Tribunal. Therefore we do not hold any information regarding the following information requests
- 3) Please give a breakdown of the number of ET1 claim forms (or excerpts and information related to the claims) received by each financial year.
- 4) Please give a list of the bodies to which these PIDA claims relate, and the number and (if practicable) the nature of ET1s received about each organisation, broken down by financial year.
- 5) Has the Housing Regulation Team undertaken any analysis of the ET1 intelligence that it has received from Employment Tribunals since April 2010? If so, please disclose all reports and or correspondence that give the details and results of the analysis/ analyses.

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you require is not held by the Welsh Government as the Housing Regulator has not dealt with any ET1 claim forms forwarded by the Employment Tribunal since 2010.

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response. Requests for an internal review should be addressed to the Welsh Government's Freedom of Information
