LiDW Connectivity Update

- Sub Speed Schools
 - 33 primary schools remained on services below the Ministerial target of 10Mbps
 - 32 of these schools expected to be delivered at target speeds by 31 March 2017
 - Llanmiloe C.P. School (Carmarthenshire) in delay with line plant issues – ECD 06 April 2017
- LiDW – Investment in Broadband
 - Cabinet Secretary for Education announcement of £5M investment to support technology limited schools
 - Engaged with local authorities to define scope for delivery in January
 - Delays caused by issues with BT BaPS around delivery methods resolved
 - Working closely with BT BaPS to provide cost model information to local authorities mid-April
 - Aim to be in a position to begin placing orders for services on 02 May

LiDW Digital tools and resources:

The LiDW programme provides all schools with access to a wide range of digital tools and resources, accessible via the Hwb Digital Learning Platform.

There are multiple suppliers involved in the delivery:

- Learning Possibilities (31 August 2018 – **no extension options**) – Hwb+ / User Provisioning
- CDSM Interactive Solutions (Re-awarded October 2016 after full OJEU process) 31 March 2019 – 2 year extension option) – Hwb / Online Safety
- Microsoft (No defined contract period) – Office 365

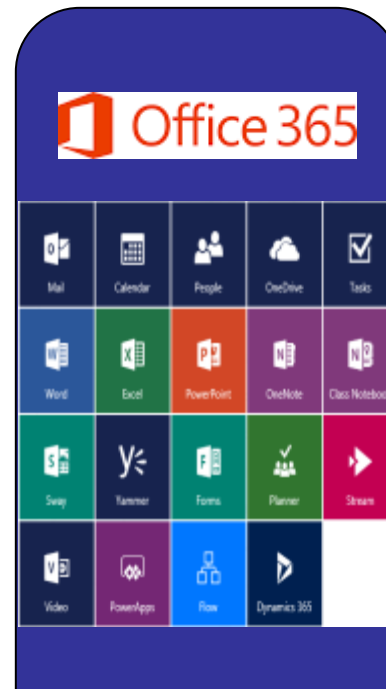

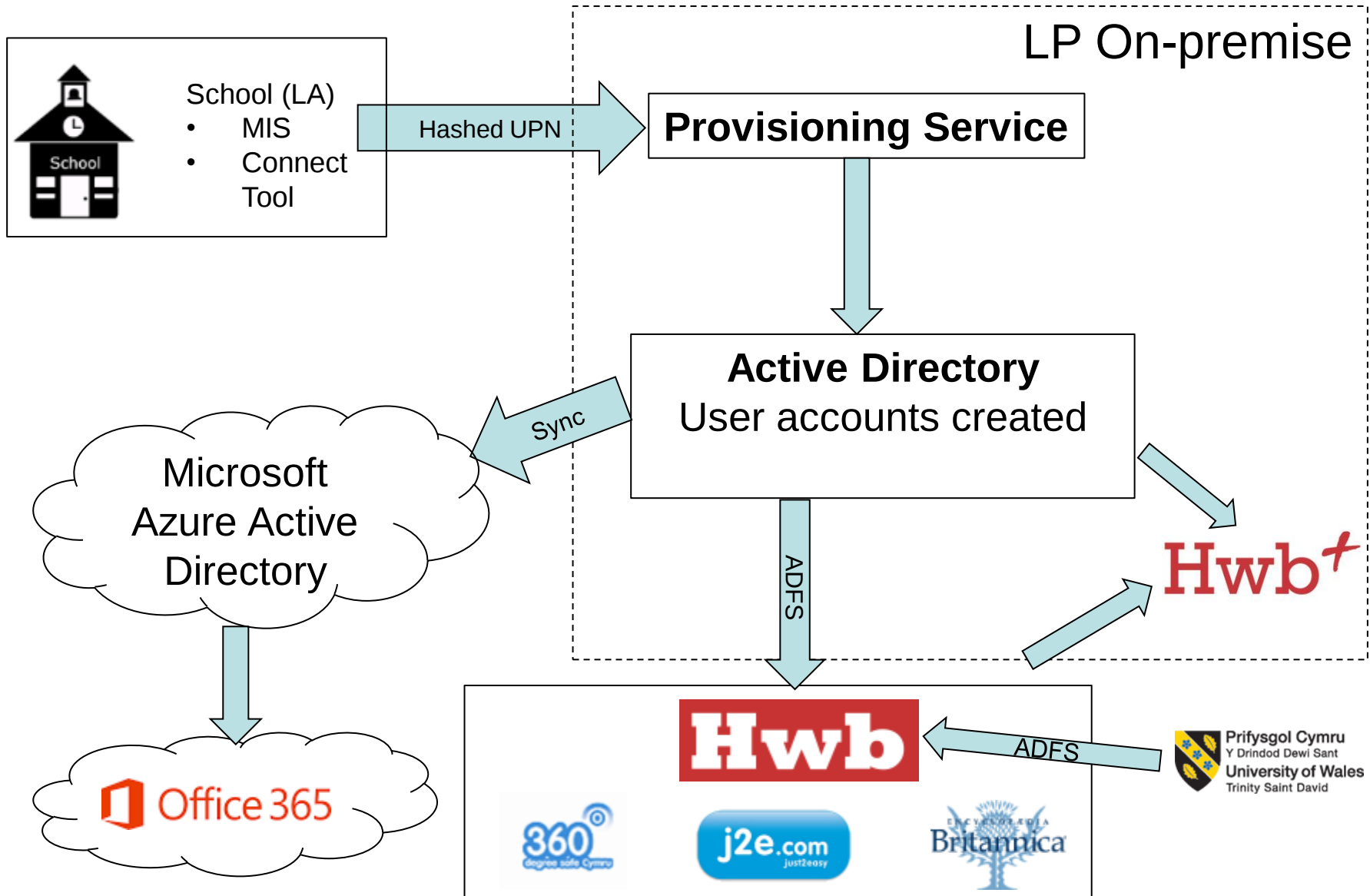

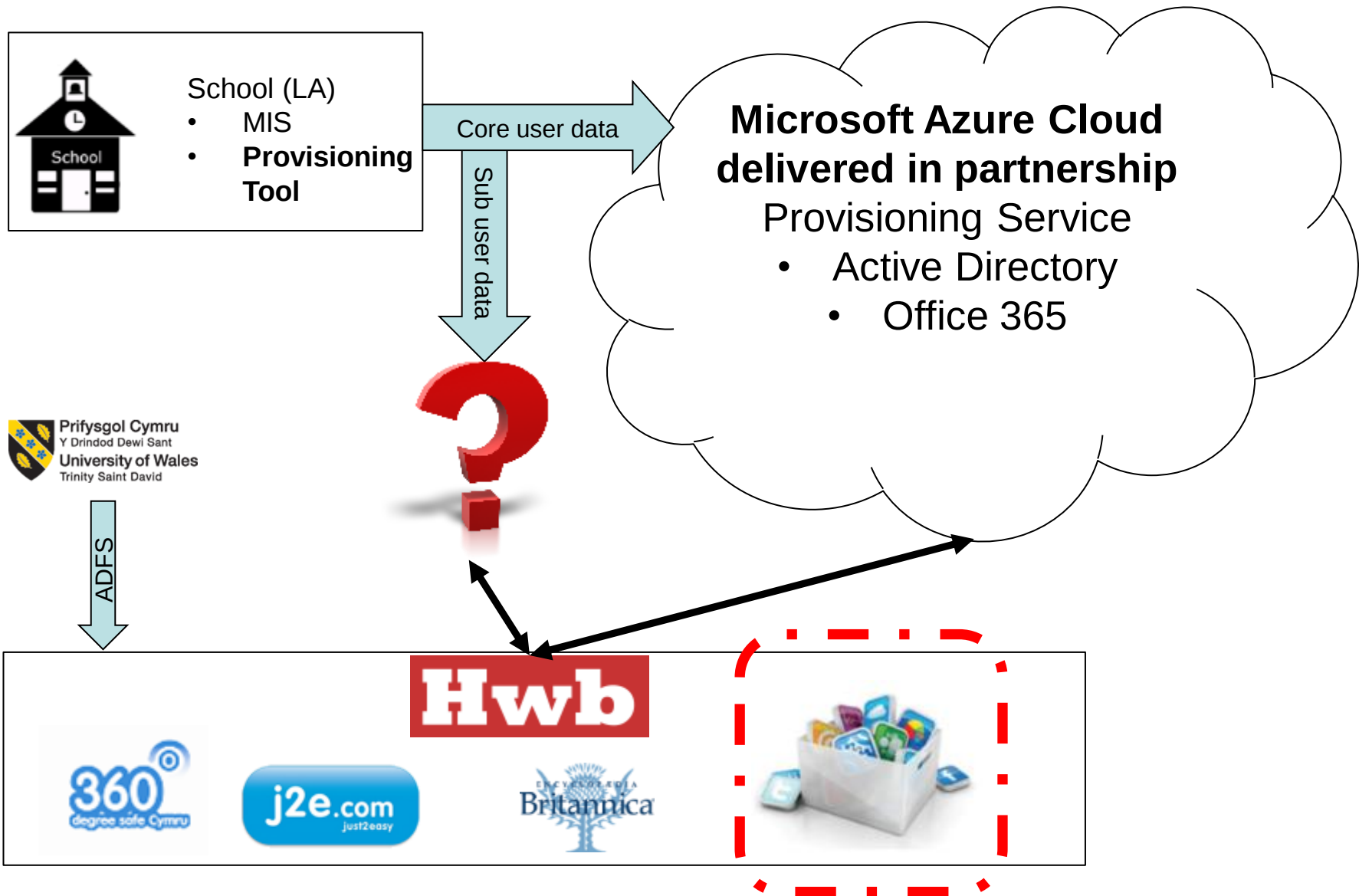

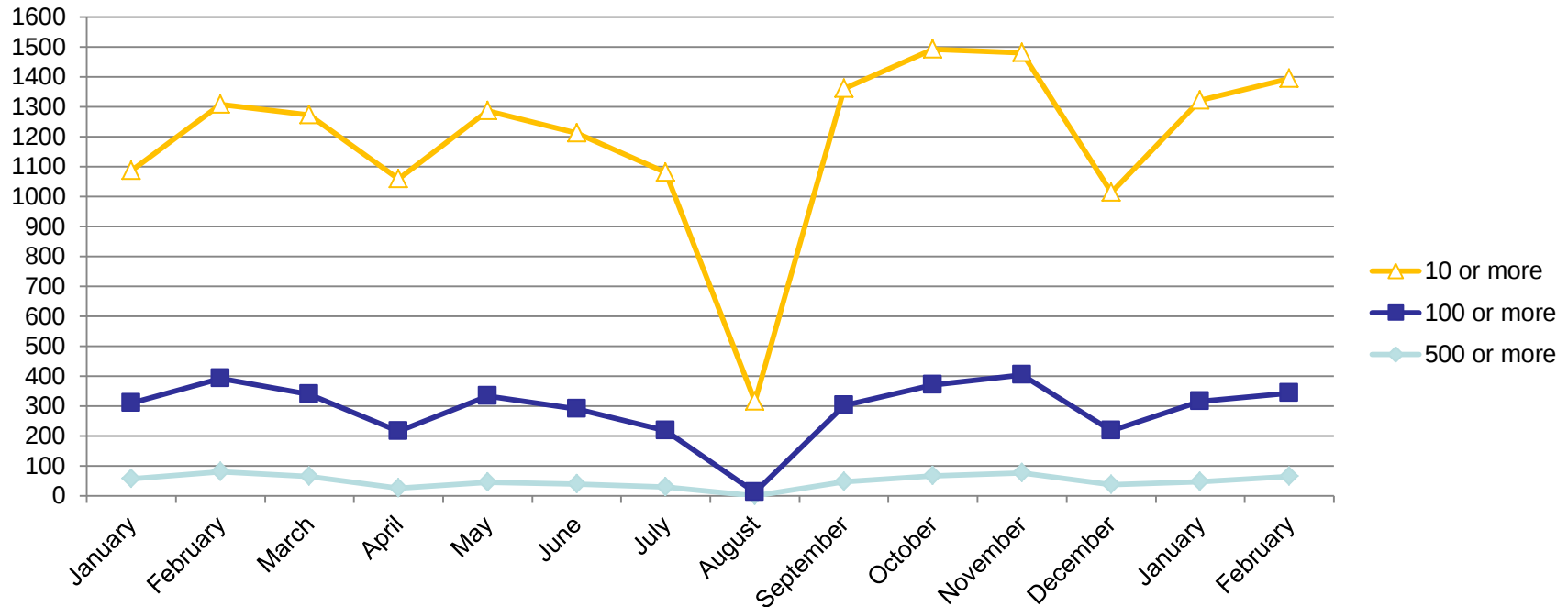
Current Provisioning Model



Proposed Provisioning Model

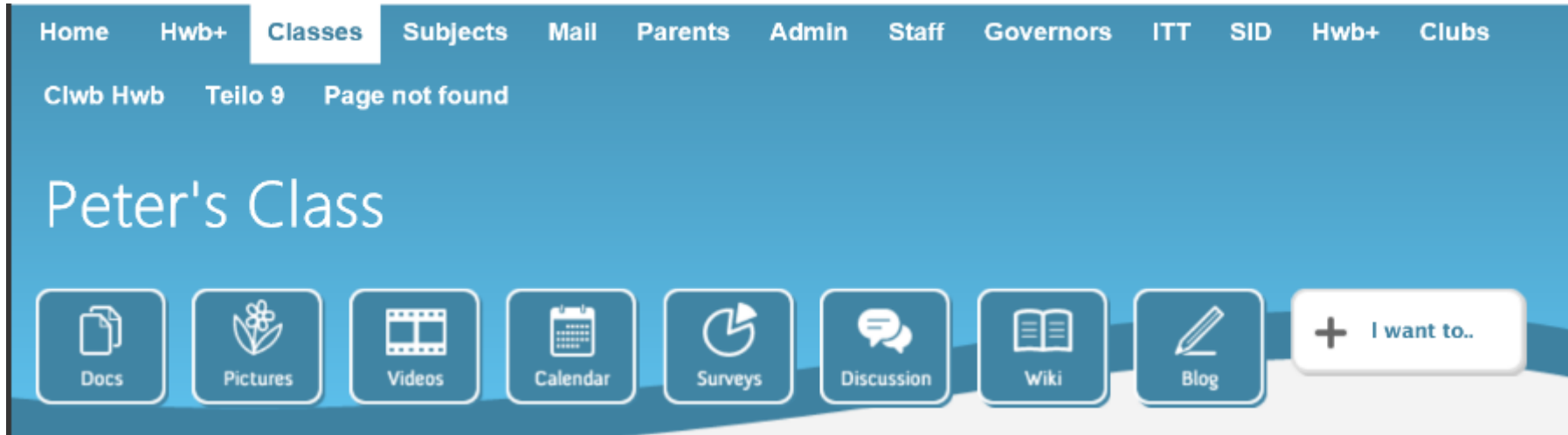


Hwb+ statistics



- 10 to 99 logins – schools which have minimal engagement in using Hwb+ (e.g. managing user passwords)
- 100 to 499 logins – schools starting to explore the use of Hwb+ with classes, (e.g. 30 learners logging in once a week)
- 500+ - schools starting to demonstrate more embedded use of Hwb+ (e.g. 30 learners logging in once a day)
