Thank you for your request which I received on 31 May. Following your clarification of your request for information, you asked whether following companies and individual had received EU funding:

- Heighway Pinball Ltd
- Heighway Pinball (Sales) Ltd
- Hydrofoils UK Ltd
- Andrew Heighway also known as (Andrew Sebastian Heighway)

I can confirm that these three companies and the individual have not received any financial assistance through the EU funding programmes in Wales. I should note, however, that in May 2016, Heighway Pinball Ltd benefited from some business support / advice (amounting to around four hours) through the EU funded Business Wales scheme, led by the Welsh Government. This scheme supports the sustainable growth of small and medium size enterprises across the country by offering access to information, guidance and business support.

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response.
