Request for Information - ATISN reference 11344

Thank you for your request which was received by the Welsh Government on 15 June 2017. I have provided the information requested against each of the questions you submitted, as follows:

Q1. The amount of money spent on display advertising by the Welsh Government in 2016/17 (excluding public notices):

£4,021,687

This includes all advertising, including TV & Radio, for all public information and tourism advertising

Q2. The amount of money broken down into print, online, social media, public spaces:

Print £1,668,538 Online £380,480 Social Media £123,913 Public Spaces £230,680 TV & Radio £1,618,076

Q3. The amount spent by the Welsh Government placing public notices in newspapers during financial year 2016-17:

Recruitment £52,524 Traffic Notices £626,526 Public Appointments £106,223

Q4. The titles of those newspapers and the amount spent with each one for the financial years mentioned above:
