Thank you for your request which I received on 29 June 2017 about schools without internet access. The information you requested is included below.

I can confirm all maintained schools in Wales have access to the internet. Following significant investment under the Learning in Digital Wales programme, all primary schools, special schools and pupil referral units have minimum broadband connections of 10Mbps; and all secondary and middle schools have a minimum of 100Mbps.
