ATISN 11448 - Mortality Rates at Brecon War Memorial and Nevill Hall Hospitals

Thank you for your request to the Welsh Government for information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) received on 01 August 2017. We have now clarified your request as follows:

- The number of deaths, including age of the deceased, at Brecon War Memorial Hospital and Nevill Hall Hospital for each year from 2012/13 to 2016/17.

The Welsh Government does not hold or publish this information. However, Caspe Health Knowledge Systems (CHKS) does hold mortality rate information pertaining to these hospitals, which is shown on the attached annex.

Note:

1. No age breakdown has been provided for Brecon War Memorial Hospital as to provide this information might be potentially disclosive. However, the majority of hospital inpatient spells at this hospital are for patients aged 65 and over.
2. Although an age breakdown has been provided for the Nevill Hall Hospital mortality rates, some information has been suppressed because the small numbers involved might also be potentially disclosive.

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response.
