Thank you for your request to the Welsh Government for information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) received on 31 July.

You asked for information in relation to pupil groups, specifically:

- The percentage of 5-15 year old pupils eligible for free school meals.
- The percentage of 5-15 year old pupils NOT "White British".
- The percentage of 5-15 year old pupils designated Special Educational Needs and Additional Learning Needs (SEN/ALN) (broad definition).
- The percentage of "Looked after Pupils".

Broken down:

- For each Local Authority separately.
- For Primary schools and secondary schools separately (group middle schools with Secondary)
- For English medium and Welsh medium schools (wide definition) separately.

The Welsh Government holds the information you have requested. We have provided the information you have requested, which is included in the attached Annex A.

Please note that we have supressed any numbers greater than 0 but less than 5, in order to protect the confidentiality of individual level data. The data in this request cannot be viewed in isolation from any other school level data set in the public domain and there is a risk that releasing these small numbers may allow an individual to be identified by deduction when this data set is combined with other data sets. This is our standard policy for publishing and presenting school statistics.
