Any Mental Illness

Adult respondents were classified as having any mental illness if they reported currently being treated for depression, anxiety, or 'another mental illness'.

Smoking

The survey asked adults whether they smoked (daily or occasionally), used to smoke (daily or occasionally), or had never smoked.

Confidence Intervals

A confidence interval can be calculated around a survey estimate, which gives a range within which the true value for the population is likely to fall.
