ATISN 11473 – Key Stage 2 results

Thank you for your request to the Welsh Government for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, received on 14 August. You asked for the following information.

During 2017:

- Pupils achieving level 5 (and above) at Key Stage 2 in core subjects.
- Summary tables with schools grouped at 0-8% EFSM, 8-16% etc. up to 32% and above.
- Welsh medium and English medium schools separately.
- For each EFSM group show the number of pupils assessed in that group.
- For Welsh medium schools only, for the same EFSM school groups, show similar tables for pupils who "Speak Welsh at home"/"Do not speak Welsh at home."
- Show the numbers of pupils in each group.
- For the sub group 32% EFSM and above only, the actual percentage of pupils who are EFSM for each group of schools/ pupils.

The information you requested is enclosed in Annex 1.

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response. Requests for an internal review should be addressed to the Welsh Government's Freedom of Information Officer at:
