ATISN 11540 - Costs of cross border treatment

Thank you for your request to the Welsh Government for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, received on 07 August. You asked for the following information:

Please provide the total cost spent on Welsh NHS patients being treated over the border in England for the years 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17.

The Welsh Government does not hold detailed information on expenditure for the treatment of Welsh patients in England, but this is included in information that is publicly available and provided in the NHS summarised accounts that are laid before the Assembly on an annual basis. Note 2.2 of these accounts includes local health board's expenditure for the treatment of their patients with non-Welsh NHS bodies. This can include expenditure with NHS organisations in Scotland and Northern Ireland, but it is predominately relating to expenditure with English NHS organisations.
