- Bills passed by the Assembly
 - Local Government Byelaws (Wales) Bill
- Bills before the Assembly
 - School Standards and Organisation (Wales) Bill
 - Food Hygiene Rating (Wales) Bill

Consultations

- Nine completed consultations relating to legislative proposals to date
 - includes Green Papers, White Papers and Draft Bills
- Eight consultations currently underway
- Commitment to consult on legislative proposals prior to introduction of a Bill

- Education (Wales) Bill

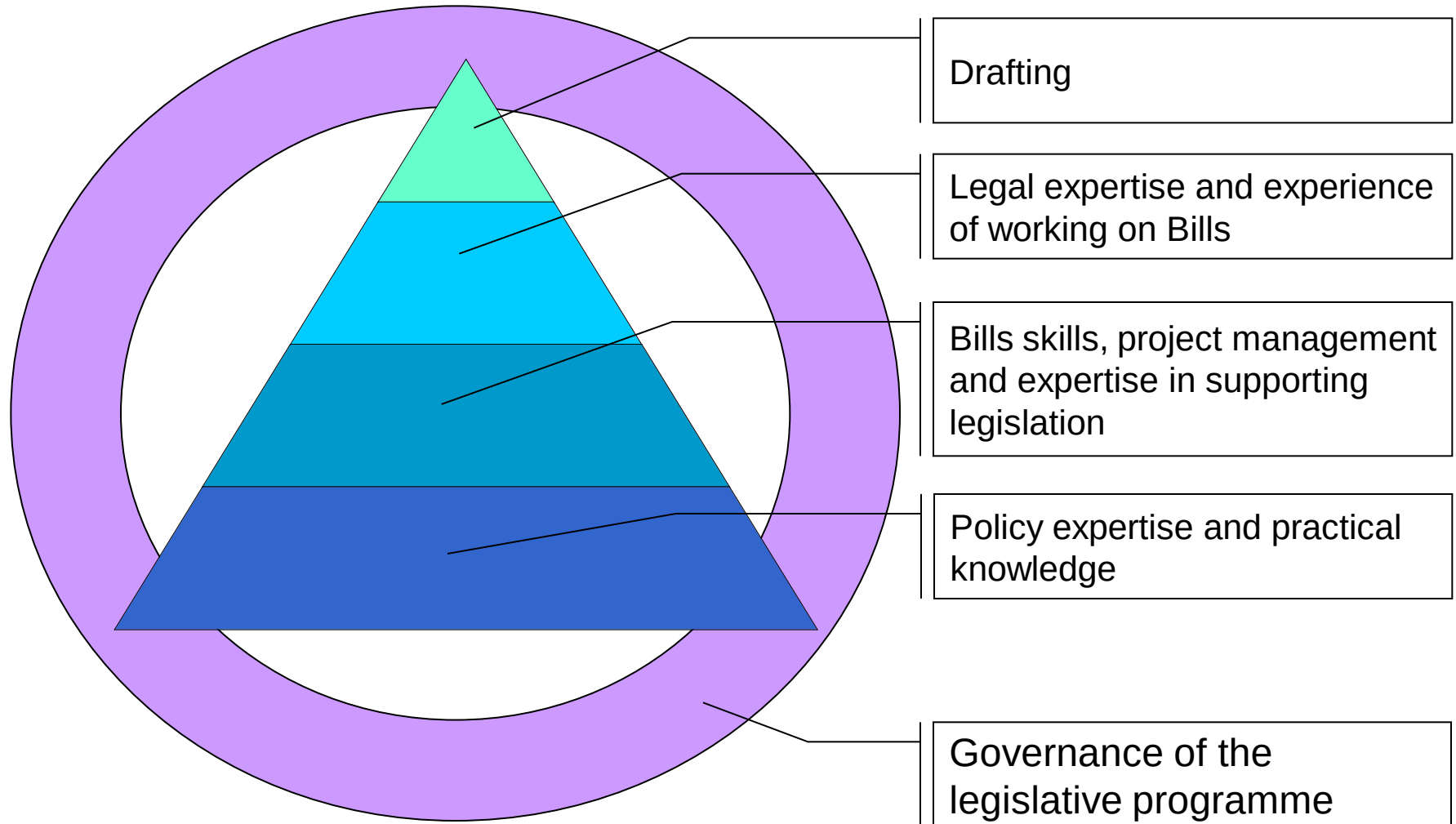

- bill skills and experience
- timetabling
- bottlenecks and capacity
- experience of Legal Services and OLC
- reporting mechanisms



Supporting delivery of the legislative programme

- Legislative Programme Board
 - provides overarching guidance and assurance to the programme
 - responsible for early identification and management of major risks to the programme, responding promptly to issues as they arise.
- Legislative Training Programme
 - new programme of training available from late September
- Legislation Handbook
- Consultation on legislation guidance





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
