Request for Information – ATISN 11481

I wrote to you on 21 August regarding your request for information. You asked for information relating to the various Enterprise Zones. I can confirm that we hold some Information relating to your request which can be seen below:

In relation to the Haven Waterway Enterprise Zone:

1. We don't hold the information in the format you have requested, however the Welsh Government holds the following information which includes passengers calling at both Milford Haven and Pembroke Ports.

2. The information requested is exempt from disclosure under Section 21 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, information otherwise reasonably available. 5. Due to the support being a combination of staff time and actual cost, as well as the event taking part some time ago under the previous contractor for the



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Business Wales service, we are unable to provide exact historic information at the level of detail required. However I can confirm that it was less than £16.8k.

14. There were regular meetings between the Welsh Government and the Energy Island Strategic Forum during this time period where the Enterprise Zone would have been referenced. Specifically, the Chair of the Anglesey Enterprise Zone Advisory Board attended 3 out of 10 Energy Island Strategic Forum meetings which took place between 2012 – March 2017.

In relation to the Central Cardiff Enterprise Zone:

In relation to the Deeside Enterprise Zone:

1. To date a total of £193.3k has been allocated to studies and the development of a full business case for the Advanced Manufacturing Skills & Technology Institute.
2. Total funds spent were £2.779m for this period
3. Total funds spent were £700.8k for this period
4. We do not hold a complete record of all enquiries in relation to the Deeside Enterprise Zone Speculative Property Scheme, but can confirm that discussions

took place with the following: Total Developments (NW) Ltd; Legat Owen; Pioneer Design & Build; TC Consult; Stuart Hogg.

5. One apprenticeship was awarded. Whilst local companies indicated to the Deeside Enterprise Zone Board that they would support the pilot scheme, they subsequently favoured recruiting in the traditional way by directly employing the apprentices.
6. £33.4k for an advertising campaign which promoted Deeside Enterprise Zone at Liverpool airport and Manchester train station.
7. Cytori Therapeutics have not drawn down any Welsh Government funding to date due to a change in their strategy for the UK, therefore no jobs have been recorded against the project.
8. 71 jobs have been confirmed as being created to date.

In relation to the Snowdonia Enterprise Zone:

1. The Welsh Government awarded £2.061m ERDF (European Regional Development Fund) to Gwynedd County Council for the Eryri Centre of Excellence which formed part of the One Big Adventure programme.
2. Welsh Government are aware that Gwynedd County Council acquired separate sources of funding that included the Community Facilities and Activities

Programme (CFAP), ENTRUST - the Landfill communities Fund, the Social Investment Fund (SIF) and the Regional Transport Programme (RTP).

3. 29 FTE.
4. Welsh Government supported Llanbedr Airfield Estates LLP and QinetiQ to establish Initial Operating Capability.
