Request for Information – ATISN reference 11528

Thank you for your request which was received by the Welsh Government on 3 September 2017. You asked for the following information:

The Welsh Assembly Government has currently registered a number of discrete public assets, held in trust for the people of Wales, as 'corporate entities'. In regard of a particular public asset described as: WELSH ASSEMBLY GOVERNMENT MID REGION ACCOUNTS located at Ladywell House Newtown, Powys SY16 1JB, Wales, holding Dun & Bradstreet no 214960579, please provide under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 the following recorded information:

- The function/purpose and/or scope of this publicly owned asset.
- The recorded necessity of registering this publicly owned asset as a corporate entity.
- The Authority under Common Law by which this publicly owned asset was appropriated and assigned to become a corporate entity.
- The date on which this publicly owned asset was registered as a corporate entity.
- The type of corporate registration assigned to this public asset conforming to Company and Commercial Law.
- The list of Company Officers detailed within documentation of registration as a corporate entity of this publicly owned asset.
- The list of Beneficiaries detailed within documentation of registration as a corporate entity of this publicly owned asset.

The Welsh Government disposed of its freehold interest in Ladywell House on 31 March 2017. Welsh Government remains in occupation in part of the building under a lease which is due to expire in March 2020. I have found no other recorded information that meets the scope of your request.
