Thank you for your request which I received on 06 October. You asked for information related to the sale of Glasdir Llanwrst, specifically:

- All documentation related to the sale of Glasdir, Llanwrst.
- The dates of the Welsh Government Cabinet and/or Committee meetings where the sale of Glasdir, Llanwrst was discussed.

The Welsh Government awarded Conwy County Borough Council a total of £1.16m of EU funds through the Objective One programme 2000–2006 to construct a facility for the provision and co-ordination of a range of business support, training providers and information sources for the rural community.

The development was completed in 2008 in line with the award of funding and the durability period for Conwy County Borough Council's project has ended. The Welsh Government does not hold any information on any sale of Glasdir.

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response.
