Request for Information – ATISN 11627

I wrote to you on 18 October regarding your request for information, which we received on 12 October. You asked for:

- A copy of the fit and proper person test report on the Directors of the Circuit of Wales project.

On 23 October I wrote to you regarding your request reference ATISN 11585, which we received on 25 September, in which you asked for the Due Diligence Report for the Circuit of Wales project. The Due Diligence Report consists of separate documents, one of which is the Corporate Intelligence report, also known as a Fit and Proper Person Test report. In my letter of 23 October, I explained that I expected to provide you with a response to your request reference ATISN 11585 by 20 November. That is still the case.

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FoIA), we are not obliged to comply with a repeated request under section 14(2) of the FoIA in the following circumstances:

- the new request is identical or substantially similar to a previous request made by the same individual making the current request;
- we have already answered the earlier request and
- there has not been a 'reasonable interval' since we answered the original request.

Because of this, I will not be processing this request any further as I consider it to be a repeated request under section 14(2) of the FoIA.

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response.
