Dear ,

Thank you for your request for information.

The National Assembly for Wales and the Welsh Government are 2 distinct organisations – the same as the UK parliament and UK government. The National Assembly for Wales is the democratically elected body that represents the interests of Wales and its people, makes laws for Wales and holds the Welsh Government to account. It has 60 elected Assembly Members (AMs). It is the Welsh equivalent to the UK parliament in Westminster, which houses every MP from across the UK. The Welsh Government is constituted by the First and other Ministers.

Within your request you have used the term Welsh Assembly Members. I have interpreted your request as therefore seeking information in respect of the National Assembly for Wales, not Welsh Government.

The Welsh Government does not hold information in respect of the National Assembly/Assembly Members. As such (and with your agreement), I would be happy to transfer your request to the National Assembly for that organisation to consider. If I do not hear from you by Friday 9 February, I can confirm Welsh Government will take no further action on your request.
