Request for Information – ATISN reference 12066

Thank you for your request which was received by the Welsh Government on 12 February 2018. You asked for the following information:

Are there any statistics available regarding patterns in Civil Service stress and absenteeism levels in Wales, over the last ten years say?

Does the Welsh Government currently endorse the use of lifelong Communication Bans or Note and File Only Orders, or is there any record of it having done so in the past? If so, approximately how many of each are still in operation?

Was Performance Related Pay ever at any time utilised in the Welsh Government, and if so between what years? Were any notes kept on the reasons for its abandonment?

In response to parts 1 and 2 of your question no information is held.

The pay arrangements for Senior Civil Servants (SCS) are determined by the UK Government. These arrangements include the ability to award performance related pay. However, the Welsh Government has taken the decision not to use performance related pay and no member of the SCS has received a payment since 2013.
