Dear Nick,

Thanks for your email. With regard to new applications, our procedure is to contact the occupants of all neighbouring properties by post. If a neighbour's name or address is not known to the applicant, we will personally call at the property and hand deliver a standard letter (please see attached). The items in grey are filled in by us.

On this occasion, the applicants informed us that the neighbouring property had been unoccupied for about a year (it was evident that the property was not inhabited). The applicants did not have an address for the then owner, other than that they had moved to Tenby - but said they had spoken to them about starting a small certificated site - and that they had no objection. We were unaware that the property was for sale.

Because of the unique circumstances, we did not put a copy of the 'neighbour notification letter' through the door of the unoccupied property - though in hindsight, we realise this is probably what we should have done.

We have since modified our procedure to ensure this cannot happen again.

I hope this information helps and apologise for the trouble this application has caused.
