Request for Information - ATISN reference 11826 - Internal Review

Thank you for your request which was received by the Welsh Government on 26 February 2018. You stated:

Copies of an email sent from the First Minister's Private Secretary to the private office of the Minister for Public Services on 4 December 2014, and the reply on 8 December 2014.

I have considered your complaint in accordance with the procedure outlined in the <u>Welsh</u> <u>Government's Practical Guide for Making Requests for Information</u>, which is available by post on request or via the internet. I have also further considered the position regarding the exemptions previously cited, those being:

- (a) the relevant information falls within the exemption from disclosure under section 35(1)(c) FOIA, as it relates to advice provided by the Law Officer;
- (b) some of the information falls within the exemption under section 42 FOIA, as it is subject to legal professional privilege; and
- (c) in relation to both section 35(1)(c) and section 42 FOIA, the public interest in maintaining the exemptions outweighs the public interest in disclosure.

In summary, I am content that the original position as stated is correct and the information requested remains exempt under section 35(1)(c) and section 42 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.
