Just to confirm, we had a meeting with the Minister and the Cab Sec for Health yesterday to discuss the Welsh Language Standards for health bodies and the MA/L that has already been submitted (MA-L/EM/0764/17).

Just to confirm the way forward - once the Minister and Cab Sec approve MA-L/EM/0764/17 to confirm that they are content with the policy direction, then we will be in a position to submit a further MA/L asking the Minister to approve:

- The Regulations themselves
- The EM/RIA
- A document summarising responses to the consultation on draft Regs.

It is worth noting that the next MA/L will be significantly shorter than the last one, as the policy issues have been outlined in the MA/L already submitted. The Minister indicated that she will probably look to lay the Regs early in January, but we will be in a position to submit the second MA/L next week if the Minister and Cab Sec are content with MA-L/EM/0764/17.
