Under Standing Order 27.8, the CWLC Committee must give the Welsh Government notice within 7 days of it being laid that they wish to scrutinise this SI (and EM/RIA), but they would need to scrutinise that documentation during the 20 days between us laying it and it being debated in Plenary. These 20 days are for committees to scrutinise legislation before it's debated.

I would advise asking for a Plenary date sooner rather than later as Plenary slots are running out fast.

I'm happy to book a Plenary slot for you, but would need to know the title of the legislation and which Cabinet Secretary or Minister is making it. We can work out the laying date from the Plenary date. Or vice versa, if you know when it is going to be ready to lay we can work out the earliest Plenary date and then try to book a slot for that date.

When you say that the MA-L will be called in for scrutiny, do you know by who? MA-Ls aren't normally used for scrutiny purposes, they are only meant to inform and advise the Cabinet Secretary/Minister.

If you mean that the legislation (along with the Explanatory Memorandum/Regulatory Impact Assessment(EM/RIA)) will be scrutinised in January, this is usually done after it has been laid. Standing Orders state that committees have 20 days (not including recesses) to scrutinise the legislation before it is then debated in Plenary. The Constitutional and Legislative Affairs Committee will automatically be sent a copy of the legislation and EM/RIA when this documentation is laid. Other interested committees will need to obtain a copy of these documents from Table Office and will have the same time scale of 20 days to report.
