ATISN 12901 Community Facilities Programme at Welsh Government

Thank you for your request which I received on 19 January 2019. I advised I would write to you in response before 14 February. You asked about funding from the Community Facilities Programme and its operation via Swansea County Council as below:

1. Is this Programme's records open to Freedom of Information Questions FolQs at WAG and/or Swansea Council?
2. Without formally asking FolQs, can you tell me now - who and where is the main contact at Swansea?
3. Do they operate under a set of rules / constitution, and if so, can I have a copy of those rules?
4. Who is the Clerk to the local Swansea CFP Committee processing this WAG held fund?
5. Are their Minutes of Meetings available for perusal - in hard copy file or via a web link and if so how can I peruse them?
6. Where is a record held of all the Grants given out by CFP in Swansea over the past four years?
7. What is a Quorum for the Swansea CFP Committee?
8. Do members have to declare (a) personal and (b) pecuniary interests?
9. Who is the formal Auditor of the Swansea based CFP Committee's distribution of public funding?

In answer to your questions, please see below:
