### **ATISN 13161 – Request for Information**

Thank you for your request and further clarification which I received on 9 May 2019. You asked for information on any third party claiming subsidy, the values attached and payments made on land at Cefn Coed Mawr, Sarnau, Brecon over the period 1 April 2016 to date.

I can confirm that the land identified in the plan submitted has been claimed for Basic Payment Scheme (BPS) and Glastir Scheme from 1 April 2016 to date. However, BPS is not paid at a set rate per hectare, rather it is calculated on the total area of eligible land available to a business, together with the total entitlements held by that business. Consequently a specific portion of payment cannot be allocated to a specific portion of land.

I am unable to disclose the identity of the person who has registered the land or details of Glastir Scheme payment as I consider this the personal information of a private person and I have been unable to obtain consent to release the information. Therefore I am withholding the information under Regulation 12 and 13 of the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 as it unduly interferes with the right of the beneficiary to respect for their private life in general and to the protection of their personal data in particular.

If you believe that no one had the right to claim on the land in any particular year(s), I would be grateful if you will let me know so that we may investigate further.

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response. Requests for an internal review should be addressed to the Welsh Government's Freedom of Information Officer at:
