## **TEACHING AND HIGHER EDUCATION ACT 1998**

## Appointment of the Student Loans Company Limited to exercise functions on behalf of the Welsh Ministers

- (1) The relevant student support functions under the Teaching and Higher Education Act 1998 are vested in the Welsh Ministers. The Minister for Education and Skills, on behalf of the Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers in section 23(4) of the Teaching and Higher Education Act 1998, hereby determines that certain of the functions exercisable by the Welsh Ministers by virtue of the Education (Student Support) (Wales) Regulations 2013 (SI 2013 No.3177(W.316)) ("the Regulations") are to be exercisable on their behalf by the Student Loans Company Limited ("the SLC").
- (2) The functions exercisable by the SLC, on behalf of the Welsh Ministers, are set out in the Schedule to this notice of appointment ("Appointment").
- (3) For the purposes of the exercise by the SLC of the functions set out in the Schedule, this Appointment has effect as of 3 April 2014.
- (4) The Functions set out in the Schedule in *Italics* are only exercisable by the SLC in relation to students who started courses on or after 1 September 2014. All other functions are exercisable by the SLC in relation to all eligible students.
- (5) The Welsh Ministers may revoke or amend this Appointment at any time, and shall notify the SLC in writing of any such amendment or revocation.
