

**The Environmental Permitting (England and Wales)
(Transitional - Exercise of Functions at Part B installations)
Direction 2008**

The Secretary of State, in relation to England, and the Welsh Ministers, in relation to Wales, in exercise of the power conferred by regulation 33(1) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2007(a), gives the following direction—

Citation, commencement and extent

1.—(1) This direction may be cited as the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) (Transitional – Exercise of Functions) Direction 2008.

(2) It comes into force on 6th April 2008.

(3) It extends to England and Wales.

(4) For the purposes of this paragraph, England and Wales have the same meaning as in the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2007 (in this direction, “the 2007 Regulations”).

Interpretation

2.—(1) “relevant operation” means a waste operation carried on at a Part B installation.

(2) Terms used in this direction and in the 2007 Regulations have the meanings given there.

Addressee

3. This direction is given to every regulator exercising functions under the 2007 Regulations.

Exercise of Functions


4. Functions under the 2007 Regulations in relation to a relevant operation are exercisable by the Agency.
